Pass Criteria for classes IX& X)

In order to be declared as having passed the examination, a candidate shall obtain a grade higher than E (i.e.at least 33% marks) in all the five subjects of external examination in the main or at the compartment examinations. The pass marks in each subject of external examination shall be 33%.

Eligibility for Compartment in Secondary Examination (Classes IX & X)

A candidate failing in **two out of five subjects** of external examination shall be placed in compartment in those subjects provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment

Pass Criteria (Senior School Certificate Examination (for Classes XI & XII)

The pass marks in each subject of external examination shall be 33%.In case of a subject involving practical work a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% marks in practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject.

Eligibility for Compartment in (Senior School Certificate Examination (For Classes XI & XII)

A candidate failing in **one of the five subjects** of external examination shall be placed in compartment in that subject provided he/she qualifies in all subjects of internal assessment.
